A series of intimate lounge and dining spaces, both indoors and out, provide numerous opportunities to entertain or simply relax and take in the picturesque environment.

Start with guided tours to local wineries and artisan food producers, enjoy the bounty on offer from The Landing's own vineyard, garden, orchards and fishing spots, select your own ingredients and pick up some tricks with personal cooking lessons.
